Neal Bascomb lived in Vemork for about 6 weeks doing research to write his book. This book is about heavy water, it's about sabotage and special operations, it's a story about people and the extraordinary things they do, and it's about Patriotism. The hero of the book is Leif Tronstad who was a chemistry professor. Neal read many diaries and letters by Tronstad. The letters written were to his daughter while he was away and in answer to her question why he had to be away so much, he stated that it was to get back the Fatherland and make it free again.


